Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute (“A.R.S”) § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona State Board of Massage Therapy (“Board”) and to the general public, that the Board will hold a meeting open to the public on **Monday, February 26, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. MST**. The executive session is not open to the public.

Any and all legal action by Board members will only take place in Open Session.

Individuals found violating this policy will be asked to modify their behavior and act civilly, and if the disorderly conduct continues, the person may be removed from the virtual meeting.
