In the interest of a prompt and judicious settlement of this case, consistent with the public interest, statutory requirements and the responsibilities of the Arizona State Board of Massage Therapy ("Board") under A.R.S. § 32-4201, *et. seq.*, Sandra Brown ("Respondent"), holder of Massage Therapist License Number MT-00607 in the State of Arizona, and the Board enter into the following Recitals, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order ("Consent Agreement") as a final disposition of this matter.

RECITALS

1. Respondent has read and understands this Consent Agreement and has had the opportunity to discuss this Consent Agreement with an attorney, or has waived the opportunity to discuss this Consent Agreement with an attorney.

2. Respondent understands that she has a right to a public administrative
 hearing concerning this matter, at which hearing she could present evidence and cross
 examine witnesses. By entering into this Consent Agreement, Respondent knowingly
 and voluntarily relinquishes all right to such an administrative hearing, as well as rights
 of rehearing, review, reconsideration, appeal, judicial review or any other administrative
 and/or judicial action, concerning the matters set forth herein.

7 3. Respondent affirmatively agrees that this Consent Agreement shall be
8 irrevocable.

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4. Respondent understands that this Consent Agreement or any part of the
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agreement may be considered in any future disciplinary action by the Board against her.

5. Respondent understands this Consent Agreement deals with Board case
number 12-102 involving allegations that Respondent engaged in conduct that would
subject her to discipline under the Board's statutes and rules. The investigation into these
allegations against Respondent shall be concluded upon the Board's adoption of this
Consent Agreement.

6. Respondent understands that this Consent Agreement does not constitute a
dismissal or resolution of any other matters currently pending before the Board, if any,
and does not constitute any waiver, express or implied, of the Board's statutory authority
or jurisdiction regarding any other pending or future investigation, action or proceeding.

7. Respondent also understands that acceptance of this Consent Agreement
does not preclude any other agency, subdivision, or officer of this State from instituting
any other civil or criminal proceedings with respect to the conduct that is the subject of
this Consent Agreement.

8. Respondent acknowledges and agrees that, upon signing this Consent Agreement and returning this document to the Board's Deputy Director, she may not

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1 revoke her acceptance of the Consent Agreement or make any modifications to the 2 document regardless of whether the Consent Agreement has been signed by the Deputy Director. Any modification to this original document is ineffective and void unless 3 4 mutually agreed by the parties in writing.

5 9. This Consent Agreement is subject to the approval of the Board and is effective only when accepted by the Board and signed by the Deputy Director. In the 6 7 event that the Board does not approve this Consent Agreement, it is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon nor introduced in any action by 8 9 any party, except that the parties agree that should the Board reject this Consent 10 Agreement and this case proceeds to hearing, Respondent shall assert no claim that the Board was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this document or any records 12 relating thereto.

13 10. If a court of competent jurisdiction rules that any part of this Consent Agreement is void or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder of the Consent Agreement 14 shall remain in full force and effect. 15

Respondent understands that this Consent Agreement is a public record that 16 11. may be publicly disseminated as a formal action of the Board and may be reported as 17 required by law to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank.

Respondent agrees that the Board will adopt the following Findings of Fact, 12. Conclusions of Law and Order.

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1 ACCEPTED AND AGREED BY RESPONDENT 2 ØD. Date: 5-13-13 Sandra Brown 3 **FINDINGS OF FACT** 4 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for licensing and regulating the 5 practice of Massage Therapy in the State of Arizona. 6 2. Respondent is the holder of license number MT-00607 to practice as a 7 8 Massage Therapist in the State of Arizona. Respondent has been licensed as a massage 9 therapist in Arizona since August 2004. 10 3. From November 2008 to September 2011, Respondent was associated with 11 the Goddess Temple in Phoenix, Arizona. While associated with the Goddess Temple, 12 Respondent engaged in sexual activity with patrons of the Goddess Temple. Patrons of 13 14 the Goddess Temple provided monetary "donations" to the Goddess Temple for sexual 15 services received. 16 4. Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for discipline under A.R.S. § 32-17 4253(A)(16) (failing to adhere to the recognized standards and ethics of the massage 18 therapy profession). 19 20 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW** 21 The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter and over 1. 22 Respondent pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-4201 et seq. The Board possesses statutory authority to enter into a consent agreement 23 2. with a massage therapist and accept the surrender of an active license from a massage 24 25 26

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1	therapist who admits to having committed an act which would subject her to discipline	
2	under the Board's statutes or rules. A.R.S. § 32-4254(N)(2).
