8 **CONSENT AGREEMENT**

9 As Alejandro Cantu-Gonzalez (“Applicant”) has made application to the Arizona
10 State Board of Massage Therapy (the “Board”) for licensure as a massage therapist and,
11 consistent with the public interest, statutory requirements and the responsibilities of the
12 Board under A.R.S. § 32-4201, *et. seq.*, the Board and Applicant enter into the following
13 Recitals, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Consent Agreement”) for
14 licensure with non-disciplinary continuing education.

15 **RECITALS**

16 1. Applicant has read and understands this Consent Agreement and has had
17 the opportunity to discuss this Consent Agreement with an attorney, or has waived the
18 opportunity to discuss this Consent Agreement with an attorney.

19 2. Applicant understands that he has a right to a public administrative hearing
20 concerning this matter, at which hearing he could present evidence and cross examine
21 witnesses. By entering into this Consent Agreement, Applicant knowingly and
22 voluntarily relinquishes all right to an administrative hearing, as well as all rights of
23 rehearing, review, reconsideration, appeal, judicial review or any other administrative
24 and/or judicial action, concerning the matters set forth herein.

25 3. Applicant affirmatively agrees that this Consent Agreement shall be
26 irrevocable.

1 4. Applicant acknowledges and agrees that, upon signing this Consent
2 Agreement and returning this document to the Board's Executive Director, he may not
3 revoke his acceptance of the Consent Agreement or make any modifications to the
4 document regardless of whether the Consent Agreement has been signed by the
5 Executive Director. Any modification to this original document is ineffective and void
6 unless mutually agreed by Applicant and the Board in writing.

7 5. Applicant understands that the Consent Agreement shall not become
8 effective unless and until signed by the Board's Executive Director on behalf of the
9 Board.


10 6. If a court of competent jurisdiction rules that any part of this Consent
11 Agreement is void or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder of the Consent Agreement
12 shall remain in full force and effect.

13 7. Applicant understands that this Consent Agreement is a public record that
14 may be publicly disseminated as a formal action of the Board.

15 8. Applicant understands that any violation of this Consent Agreement may
16 result in disciplinary action. A.R.S. § 32-4253(A)(23).
