

1 therapist's license under A.R.S. § 32-4225. The remainder of the continuing
2 education hours required by this Order shall be in addition to the hours required
3 for the renewal of Respondent's massage therapist license under A.R.S. § 32-
4 4225.

5 b. After completion of the Respondent's Criminal Probation, Respondent shall
6 request in writing that the Board terminate his probation. Respondent's request
7 for termination will be considered at a regularly scheduled Board meeting.

8 Respondent is required to personally appear at that Board meeting. Respondent's
9 probationary period will continue until Respondent's request for termination is
10 received and the Board terminates the probation.

11 c. Within ten (10) days of the effective date of this order, Respondent shall
12 enroll and participate in a 10-panel screen random urine drug testing schedule,
13 specifically to include alcohol testing, wherein Respondent is tested at least
14 quarterly. The drug testing shall be performed by a drug testing facility pre-
15 approved by Board staff.¹ Respondent shall furnish the testing facility with a copy
16 of this Order and shall authorize and require the testing facility to submit test
17 results directly to the Board. In addition, Respondent shall authorize and require
18 the testing facility to immediately notify the Board of any failure by Respondent to
19 appear and be tested when requested to do so by the testing facility. Any positive
20 drug test for a prohibited substance or any failure by Respondent to appear and be
21 tested when requested to do so by the testing facility is a violation of this Order.

22 c. Respondent shall actively participate in Alcoholics Anonymous ("AA")
23 and/or Narcotics Anonymous ("NA") with an active sponsor. Respondent shall

1 attend AA/NA meetings at least once per week. Respondent shall provide proof of
2 his AA/NA attendance to Board staff on a quarterly basis, with the first
3 documentation of attendance due by May 31, 2015.

4 d. Throughout the term of Respondent's probation, Respondent shall furnish
5 all massage therapy employers with a copy of this Order.

6 e. Respondent shall pay all necessary fees and complete all continuing
7 education requirements throughout the term of his probation to maintain Massage
8 Therapist License No. MT-04111P.

9 f. Throughout the term of Respondent's probation, Respondent shall
10 personally appear before the Board when requested to do so by the Board or Board
11 staff. In addition, Respondent shall appear before the Board when he seeks to
12 renew his massage therapy license, which is due to expire on June 2, 2015.

13 g. Respondent shall obey all federal and state laws and rules governing the
14 practice of Massage Therapists.

15 2. Respondent shall pay all costs associated with complying with this Order.

16 3. If Respondent violates this Order in any way or fails to fulfill the
17 requirements of this Order, the Board, after giving the Respondent notice and the
18 opportunity to be heard, may revoke, suspend or take other disciplinary actions against
19 Respondent's license. The issue at such a hearing will be limited solely to whether this
20 Order has been violated.


21 **NOTICE**

22 Respondent is hereby notified of the right to petition for review by filing a
23 petition with the Board's Executive Director within thirty (30) days after service of this
24 Order. A.A.C. R4-15-401(A). The petition must set forth legally sufficient reasons for
25 granting review. A.A.C. R4-15-401(C). Service of this order is effective five (5) days

1 after mailing. If a petition for review is not filed, the Board's Order becomes effective
2 thirty-five (35) days after it is mailed to Respondent.

3 Respondent is further notified that the filing of a petition for review is required to
4 preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
