**ORDER FOR CONTINUING
EDUCATION**

(NON-DISCIPLINARY)

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8 At its public meeting on July 28, 2014, the Arizona Board of Massage Therapy
9 (“Board”) considered case number 14-106. Cuihua Gong (“Respondent”) failed to
10 report her September 20, 2013, charges in Phoenix Municipal Court for violations of
11 Phoenix City Code 10-25.3(A)(2)(a) (providing or offering to provide any service in a
12 manner or under circumstances intended to arouse, appeal or gratify sexual desires) and
13 Phoenix City Code 10-25.3(A)(3) (intentionally viewing a completely or partially
14 disrobed massage establishment client) as required by A.R.S. § 32-3208(A).
15 Respondent’s charges were dismissed on March 20, 2014. Based upon its concerns that
16 Respondent failed to timely report the charges to the Board, the Board voted to require
17 Respondent to obtain a total of 6 hours of non-disciplinary continuing education in
18 ethics and business practices.

19 **ORDER**

20 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that within ninety (90) days of the effective date of
21 this Order, Respondent shall complete a total of 6 hours of Board Staff pre-approved
22 continuing education in ethics and business practices. The continuing education hours
23 must be obtained either in person or through an interactive web-based seminar. The
24 continuing education hours shall be in addition to the hours required for the renewal of
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1 her massage therapy license. Respondent's failure to complete the continuing education
2 will subject her to future disciplinary action by the Board. A.R.S. § 32-4253(A)(23).

3 **NOTICE**

4 Respondent is hereby notified of the right to petition for review by filing a
5 petition with the Board's Executive Director within thirty (30) days after service of this
6 Order. A.A.C. R4-15-401(A). The petition must set forth legally sufficient reasons for
7 granting review. A.A.C. R4-15-401(C). Service of this order is effective five (5) days
8 after mailing. If a petition for review is not filed, the Board's Order becomes effective
9 thirty-five (35) days after it is mailed to Respondent.

10 Respondent is further notified that the filing of a petition for review is required to
11 preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.

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
