Elizabeth Campbell, Assistant Attorney General, 13 appeared on behalf of the State. Neither Respondent nor Respondent's attorney appeared at the Board meeting. Christopher Munns of the Solicitor General's Office was available to provide 14 independent legal advice to the Board. 15 After reviewing the record, the Board granted the State's Motion to Deem Allegations 16 Admitted. Based upon A.R.S. § 32-4254(H) and the Complaint and Notice of Hearing filed in 17 this matter, the Board issues the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order. 18 PARTIES AND JURISDICTION 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for licensing and regulating the practice 19 of massage therapy in the State of Arizona. 20 2. Respondent is the holder of license number MT-19170, which allows her to practice 21 as a massage therapist in the State of Arizona. 22 3. Under A.R.S. § 32-4201, et seq., the Board possess jurisdiction over the subject 23 matter and over Respondent as a licensee of the Board. 24 25

	FINDINGS OF FACT	
1	1. On or about November 20, 2014, Respondent was convicted of Child Abuse, a class	
2	6 undesignated felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case number CR2014-148592.	
3	2. Respondent failed to notify the Board that she had been charged with the offense	
4	within 10 days after the charge was filed.	
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6	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW	
7	1. The felony conviction described above is grounds for discipline under A.R.S. § 32-	
	4253(A)(4) (Being convicted of a felony or other offense involving moral turpitude or conviction	
8	for prostitution, solicitation or another similar offense. A conviction by a court of competent	
9	jurisdiction is conclusive evidence of the commission of the crime).	
10	2. The conviction described above is grounds for discipline under A.R.S. § 32- 4253(A)(10) (Engaging in conduct that could result in harm or injury to the public).	
11	3. A class 6 undesignated felony is treated as a felony for all purposes until such time	
12	as a court may actually enter an order designating the offense as a misdemeanor. A.R.S. § 13-	ļ
13	604(A).	
14	4. The conduct described in the Factual Allegations paragraph 2 constitutes	
15	unprofessional conduct under A.R.S. § 32-3208(A) and (D), which provide that it is unprofessional	
	conduct for a health professional who has been charged with a misdemeanor involving conduct	
16	that may affect patient safety or a felony after receiving or renewing a license or certificate to fail	
17	to notify the health professional's regulatory board in writing within ten working days after the	
18	charge is filed.	
19	ORDER	
20	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that respondent's license is Revoked.
