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3 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

4 1. On or about May 6, 2010, Respondent was convicted of possession of burglary tools, a  
5 class 6 undesignated felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case number CR2010-117782.

6  
7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 1. The felony conviction described above is grounds for discipline under A.R.S. § 32-  
9 4253(A)(4) (Being convicted of a felony or other offense involving moral turpitude or  
10 conviction for prostitution, solicitation, or other similar offense. A conviction by a court of  
11 competent jurisdiction is conclusive evidence of the commission of the crime).

12 2. A class 6 undesignated felony is treated as a felony for all purposes until such time as a  
13 court may actually enter an order designating the offense as a misdemeanor. A.R.S, § 13-702(G).

15 **ORDER**

16 Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED  
17 that Respondent's license number MT-13900 is REVOKED.

18  
19 **RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW**

20 Respondent has the right to petition for a rehearing or review of this Order. Pursuant to A.R.S. §  
21 41-1092.09 and A.A.C. R4-15-401(A), the petition must be filed with the Board within thirty-  
22 five (35) days from the date of mailing if the Order was served by certified mail. The petition  
23 must set forth legally sufficient reasons for granting the rehearing or review pursuant to A.A.C.  
24 R4-15-401(C). The timely filing of a motion for rehearing or review shall stay the enforcement  
25 of the Board's Order. If a motion for rehearing or review is not filed, the Board's Order becomes

1 effective thirty-five (35) days after it is mailed, unless pursuant to A.A.C. R4-15-401(F), the  
2 Board has expressly found good cause to believe that this Order shall be effective immediately  
3 upon the issuance and has so stated in this Order.
