## ADVISORY LETTER

RE: Case No. 21-109

Dear Mr. Martinez:

The Arizona State Board of Massage Therapy (the "Board") is charged with the responsibility of regulating the massage therapy profession. The Board has completed its investigation of the information received in Case No. 21-109. After discussion and deliberation at its meeting on March 29, 2021, the Board voted to issue you this Advisory Letter.

While the Board found that your actions do not merit discipline against your license as the allegations arise from an event that is alleged to have occurred 7 years ago. Specifically, the Board was concerned with your actions towards AS and the possibility you engaged in conduct that could result in harm to the public, as well as the potential for sexual misconduct with a client.

An Advisory Letter is not a disciplinary action, but it is a matter of public record. An Advisory Letter is not subject to review by the Board or the Courts. See Murphy v. Board of Medical Examiners of the State of Arizona, 190 Ariz. 441, 449, 949 P.2d 530, 538 (App. 1997). However, pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-4254(F)(2), you may file a written response to this Advisory Letter with the Board within thirty days after its receipt.
