7. The conduct and circumstances described above constitute grounds for discipline pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-4253(A)(16) (failing to adhere to the recognized standards and ethics of the massage therapy profession).

## ORDER

Based on the Board's adoption of the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Board issues the following Order:

It is ordered **REVOKING** Respondent's massage therapy license no. MT-23746.

It is further ordered that, within 30 days of the date of this Order, Respondent shall: 1) **REIMBURSE** AM \$45 for the services she paid for on August 27, 2017; and 2) submit written confirmation to the Board that he has timely reimbursed AM.

It is further ordered that, within 30 days of the date of this Order, Respondent shall: 1) **REIMBURSE** LS \$90 for the services she paid for on August 15, 2017; and 2) submit written confirmation to the Board that he has timely reimbursed LS.

The effective date of this Decision and Order is the date that is signed by Board's Executive Director.

## NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS

Respondent is hereby notified that he has the right to request a rehearing or review by filing a petition with the Board's Executive Director within 30 days after service of this Decision and Order. Service of this Decision and Order is effective on the date of personal delivery or five

1	days after the date of mailing. A.R.S. § 41-1092.09. The request for a rehearing or review must
2	set forth legally sufficient reasons for granting a rehearing or review. A.A.C. R4-15-401(C). If a
3	motion for rehearing or review is not filed, the Board's Decision and Order becomes effective 35
4	days after it is mailed to Respondent. Respondent is further notified that the filing of a motion for
5	rehearing or review is required to preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
