FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

Pursuant to Notice of Hearing Number 12-111 (Notice) this matter came before the Arizona 11 Board of Massage Therapy (Board) on November 26, 2012. 12 Dennis Beye, president, presided at the meeting with Board members Victoria Bowman, John 13 Ortega, Diane Pruetz, and Earl Duskey in attendance. 14 The State was represented by the Office of the Attorney General, Elizabeth Campbell, Assistant 15 Attorney General, Licensing and Enforcement Section. Christopher Munns, of the Solicitor 16 General's Section of the Attorney General's Office was present and available to provide 17 independent legal advice to the Board. (Respondent) was not present. The Board, after 18 considering the testimony and evidence presented, hereby issues the following Findings of Fact, 19 Conclusions of Law, and Order. 20 AUTHORITIES AND JURISDICTION 21 The Board is the duly constituted authority for licensing and regulating the practice of 1. 22 massage therapy in the state of Arizona. 23 Respondent is the holder of license number MT-06349, which allows her to practice as a 2. 24

25 massage therapist in the state of Arizona.

3. Under A.R.S. § 32-4201, *et seq.*, the Board possesses jurisdiction over the matter and over Respondent as a licensee of the Board.

FINDINGS OF FACT

On September 5, 2012, Respondent was convicted of Facilitation to Commit Illegal 1. Control of an Enterprise, a class 6 felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court (Court) case number CR2011-005314.

2. Respondent failed to notify the Board that she had been charged with the offense within 10 days after the charge was filed. The Board was kept informed of the status of the case by Scottsdale police officers.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The felony conviction described above in the Findings of Fact, paragraph 1, is grounds 1. for discipline under A.R.S. § 32-42-53(A)(4) (Being convicted of a felony or other offense involving moral turpitude or conviction for prostitution, solicitation or another similar offense. A conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction is conclusive evidence of the commission of the crime).

The conduct described in the Findings of Fact, paragraph 2, constitutes unprofessional 2. conduct under A.R.S. § 32-3208(A) and (D), which provide that it is unprofessional conduct for a health professional who has been charged with a misdemeanor involving conduct that may affect patient safety or a felony after receiving or renewing a license or certificate to fail to notify the health professional's regulatory board in writing within ten working days after the charge is filed.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Board IT IS HEREBY **ORDERED** that Respondent's license number MT-06349 IS REVOKED.

RIGHT TO PETITON FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW

Respondent has the right to petition for a rehearing or review of this Order. Pursuant to A.R.S. §

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1	41-1092.09 and A.A.C. R4-15-401(A), the petition must be filed with the Board within thirty-
2	five (35) days from the date of mailing if the Order was served by certified mail. The petition
3	must set forth legally sufficient reasons for granting the rehearing or review pursuant to A.A.C.
4	R4-15-401(C). The timely filing of a motion for rehearing or review shall stay the enforcement
5	of the Board's Order. If a motion for rehearing or review is not filed, the Board's Order becomes
6	effective thirty-five (35) days after it is mailed, unless pursuant to A.A.C. R4-15-401(F), the
7	Board has expressly found good cause to believe that this Order shall be effective immediately.
