1 BEFORE THE ARIZONA BOARD 2 OF MASSAGE THERAPY EXAMINERS 3 In the Matter of JONATHON THOMPSON, LMT, FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS Holder of License No. MT-07160 OF LAW, AND ORDER As a Massage Therapist In the State of Arizona 4 5 6 Pursuant to Notice of Hearing Number 14-100, this matter came before the Arizona Board of 7 Massage Therapy (Board) on February 23, 2015. 8 Dennis Beye, Chair, presided at the meeting with Board members Victoria Bowman, John Ortega, 9 Earl Duskey, and Diane Pruetz in attendance. 10 The state was represented by the Office of the Attorney General, Elizabeth Campbell, Assistant 11 Attorney General, Licensing and Enforcement Section. Chris Munns, of the Solicitor General's 12 Section of the Attorney General's Office was present and available to provide independent legal 13 advice to the Board. Jonathon Thompson (Respondent) was present and was represented by 14 attorney Tom Gorman. The Board, after considering the testimony and evidence presented, hereby 15 issues the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order 16 PARTIES AND JURISDICTION 17 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for licensing and regulating the practice 18 of massage therapy in the State of Arizona. 19 2. Respondent is the holder of license number MT-07160, which allows him to 20 practice as a massage therapist in the State of Arizona. 21 3. Under A.R.S. § 32-4201, et seq., the Board possess jurisdiction over the subject 22 matter and over Respondent as a licensee of the Board.

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FINDINGS OF FACT

- 2 1. On April 2, 2013, female massage therapy client ZM received a massage from
- 3 Respondent at Hozho Shiatsu & Massage in Cottonwood, Arizona.
- 4 2. During the massage, which was ZM's fourth massage with Respondent,
- 5 Respondent touched and massaged ZM's breasts. ZM had not consented to a breast massage.
- 6 During ZM's previous appointment with Respondent, ZM noticed that Respondent's draping was
- 7 looser and Respondent had exposed ZM's breast.
- 8 3. In approximately 2008, DS received a massage from Respondent in Cottonwood,
- 9 Arizona. During the massage, Respondent exposed DS's breast and touched DS's breast.

10 <u>CONCLUSIONS OF LAW</u>

- 1. The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter and over Respondent
- 12 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-4201 et seq.

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- 13 2. The Board may discipline a massage therapist who has engaged in sexual activity
- 14 with a client. A.R.S. § 32-4253(A)(15).
- The conduct and circumstances with regard to ZM and DS constitute sexual activity
- in violation of A.R.S. § 32-4253(B)(2)(d) ("Sexual activity" means intentionally viewing a
- 17 completely or partially disrobed massage therapy client in the course of treatment if the viewing
- is not related to treatment under current practice standards and is intended to appeal to the prurient
- interest of the massage therapy client or the massage therapist).
- 20 6. The conduct and circumstances described above constitute sexual activity in
- violation of A.R.S. § 32-4253(B)(2)(e) ("Sexual activity" means massaging, touching or applying
- 22 any instrument or device by a licensee in the course of practicing or engaging in massage therapy

1	to the breasts' of a female client unless the client requests breast massage and signs a written
2	consent).
3	<u>ORDER</u>
4	Based on the foregoing Finding of Fact and Conclusions of Law, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED
5	that Respondent's license number MT-07160 is suspended for 90 days, followed by one year of
6	probation beginning on the last day of suspension. During the probationary period Respondent
7	shall complete 20 hours of staff preapproved continuing education consisting of four hours of
8	draping and 16 hours in ethics, boundaries and communications. This continuing education is in
9	addition to the 24 hours required for license renewal. Respondent shall appear before the Board to
10	request release from probation.
11	RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW
12	Respondent has the right to petition for a rehearing or review of this Order. Pursuant to A.R.S. §
13	41-1092.09 and A.A.C. R4-15-401(A), the petition must be filed with the Board within thirty-
14	five (35) days from the date of mailing if the Order was served by certified mail. The petition
15	must set forth legally sufficient reasons for granting the rehearing or review pursuant to A.A.C.
16	R4-15-401(C). The timely filing of a petition for rehearing or review shall stay the enforcement
17	of the Board's Order. If a petition for rehearing or review is not filed, the Board's Order becomes
18	effective thirty-five (35) days after it is mailed, unless pursuant to A.A.C. R4-15-401(F), the
19	Board has expressly found good cause to believe the Order shall be effective immediately upon
20	the issuance and has so stated in the Order. The failure to file a petition for rehearing or review
21	within thirty-five (35) days after mailing has the effect of prohibiting the parties from seeking
22	judicial review of the Board's decision.
